About Inner Wheel

Inner Wheel began in Great Britain during World War I when Rotarians, overburdened with service demands, asked their wives to help with their Rotary commitments. Friendships were formed through their service projects and the seeds of Inner Wheel were sown.

In the following years, Inner Wheel Clubs were formed throughout Great Britain. International Inner Wheel was founded in 1967 and now links together approximately 103 geographical locations with more than 100,000 members worldwide. International Inner Wheel has United Nations representation in New York, Vienna, and Geneva.

To extend the Red Rose of Friendship to more women, new categories of membership have been developed, allowing nearly all women in a Rotarian's family the opportunity to join Inner Wheel.



Contributions

The Inner Wheel U.S.A. Foundation, Inc. is a 501(C)(3) non-profit charity, recognized by the IRS. We welcome contributions from individual Inner Wheel members, Clubs and Districts as well as from sources outside of Inner Wheel. All contributions are tax deductible under current tax law.

Acknowledgements will be issued when contributions are received. A certificate and Rose Council pin will be given when an initial \$1,000 contribution has been made.

Recognition Levels

Rose Council \$1,000 - \$1,999
Jeweled Rose \$ 2,000

For each \$1,000 to \$5,000 donation, a jewel will be added. When a recipient reaches the \$5,000 donation level, the middle jewel will be replaced with a Sapphire. At \$10,000, another jewel will be replaced with a Ruby and at \$25,000, an Emerald will be added.

Sustaining Contributor

A sustaining contributor is anyone who contributes a minimum of \$100, with the commitment to accrue a total of \$1,000 in donations within a ten year period.

Sustaining contributors are eligible for a Rose Council Pin and Certificate when the total \$1,000 has been received.
